Dear Parents/Carers

As I am sure you are aware on Monday 28 June 2021 a small number of residents of Halton Place held a protest by blocking the road with wheelie bins. We worked with the police who attended and together with my staff ensured students were able to leave school safely. A number of you were inconvenienced by the protest as you were unable to pick your children up from Halton Place and students leaving on bikes were delayed for safety reasons.

I have been in contact with the local police who are supporting the Academy and will attend again should any further protests take place. The trust has also arranged for more site staff to be available at the beginning and end of the day to join my duty staff.

The Academy wishes to have good relations with all of our neighbours and the local residents in the local area. Therefore, I would ask parents not to park in Halton Place and under no circumstances block the driveways of residents. The Academy intends to continue using the Halton Place entrance as this is more convenient for some students, reduces the numbers of students using the Grainsby Avenue entrance and helps congestion in the area, especially now that there are more students on site than in previous years. I would be very grateful if parents could help the Academy in being as respectful and thoughtful as possible to local residents including those living in Halton Place when picking up their children. I am sure if all parties are considerate then the Halton Place entrance can be used harmoniously moving forward.
