Curriculum

Cleethorpes Academy students enjoy a broad and balanced curriculum that provides them with the skills they need for adult life.

Timetables will be made up of an exciting range of subjects that develop your child's interests and abilities. Alongside the traditional subject areas, students are offered enrichment opportunities to develop their skills for life.

Assessment

The Academy take a holistic approach to assessment. Student's work and effort in the classroom is continuously reviewed and shared with Parent/ Carers.

Each student receives three reports over the academic year. These reports comment on their progress and attainment, behaviour, homework and classwork. Student's strengths are shared as well as opportunities for development.









Pastoral Care

Cleethorpes Academy has a very strong sense of community and this is supported with a House system. The three Houses are called Capella, Rigel and Sirius and are led by a Head of House. Every student is placed into a House when they join the Academy.

We have a vertical tutor system which means that each tutor group will have a selection of students from each year. Every student has daily contact with their tutor and regular House and year assemblies to support their emotional and well-being needs. Students are rewarded for their efforts, whether in sport, music, reading or in the community.



Extra-Curricular

Cleethorpes Academy offers an extensive extra-curricular programme that students can enjoy. Learning does not stop in the classroom and the benefits of offering such a large range of extra-curricular activities enhances the opportunities available to the students.

The Academy offers music tuition through highly qualified and experienced instructors. The very successful Physical Education Department run a dedicated sports programme.
